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Program Description

The scholarship program is administered by the Directors of the California Association of Meat Processors (CAMP). The number of awards and the amount of each award is at the discretion of the Directors.

SCHOLARSHIP

The California Association of Meat Processors Scholarship \$750.

AWARDS

The CAMP Scholarship will be distributed after receiving proof of enrollment for the academic year of the scholarship, a check will be issued directly to the recipient.

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

The purpose of the scholarship is to encourage undergraduate students to pursue a curriculum leading to a B.S. in a field related to Meat, Animal, Food Science or related discipline. It is anticipated that the recipient will have a desire to seek a career in the meat industry but not mandatory.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicants must meet the following eligibility requirements in order to apply for a CAMP Scholarship award.

2. Applicants must be attending a 4-year college or university in California.

3. Applicants must have a cumulative 2.0 Grade Point Average (GPA) to apply.

4. Applicants must have the recommendation of a faculty member familiar with their work.

Interview...All applicants are encouraged to attend CAMP's Annual Convention.

All unsolicited materials, including photos, cover sheets and folders, will be discarded. Incomplete applications, late submittals, applications that do not meet the **2.0 GPA minimum** requirement, or grades not submitted in the A = 4.00 system will be cause for disgualification. 5. Scholarship applicants must be enrolled in an approved program at the time the scholarship becomes effective. Freshmen who apply must be sophomores at the time the scholarship becomes effective.

6. Applicants who receive an award must remain enrolled throughout the school year.

7. Senior students must enroll as undergraduates for two consecutive semesters (or equivalent) beyond the effective date, (September 1, 2025) of the scholarship.

Financial need, age, gender, or national origins are not conditions of eligibility for any of the awards.

Prior year recipients not eligible.

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NOTIFICATION

Scholarship award will be announced by March $1^{\rm st}, 2025$ or at the Annual Convention.

Scholarship awards are based on the following:

A) Scholastics - Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.0 (A= 4.0) at the time of application submission. The recipients must maintain a 2.0 GPA with a minimum course load of 12units per semester, (or the equivalent) and remain in good academic standing during the term of the scholarship.

B) Work Experience and Career Goals – Preference will be placed upon applicants who have demonstrated experience working in the meat industry whether it be in a commercial plant or university meat lab. Applicants career plans and work experience should be directed towards working in or for the meat industry preferably in post-harvest production.

C) Other Activities ~ Applicants should cite activities that demonstrate leadership gualities, intellectual growth and breadth of interest.

D) A selection committee made up of CAMP members will evaluate applications and recommend recipients to the CAMP Board of Directors who will then approve the selection.

E) Completed applications must be received by the CAMP Scholarship Committee on or before February 1, 2025

Complete the attached scholarship application. Application criteria are weighted as indicated in parentheses.

Career Goals Essay ...Prepare a typed 300–350 word essay outlining your career goals and future endeavors. The essay should focus on how these goals and career objectives might pertain to or benefit post-harvest and production of meat products. The essay should also include your reason for applying for the scholarship other than financial need. Financial need, age, gender, race, religion or national origins are not conditions for eligibility. (20%)

Work Experience... Provide a summary of your work experience, especially as it relates to the commercial meat industry, university meat lab employment, and other food processing related work experience. (30%)

Awards and Honors...Provide a list of university awards and honors received. (5%)

Extracurricular Activities... Provide a list of extracurricular activities that demonstrate intellectual growth, breadth of

interests, talents and leadership gualities. (5%)

Faculty Letter of Recommendation...Include a letter of recommendation signed by a faculty member. (10%)
